(2) Visit every location by bicycle (driving to the finish is OK). Always wear your helmet.

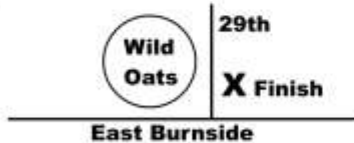
(3) Asking people for help is OK and a very good idea!

(5) All clues lie within these boundaries:

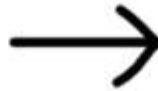
